### GOOD NEWS STORIES MARCH 2018

**BURGLARY CONVICTIONS** Two male youths appeared at Highbury Corner Magistrates court this month both charged with burglary and attempted burglary which occurred in King Street in November. This was as the result of an investigation by the dedicated ward officers which identified the offenders who live locally on a neighbouring ward. They were found guilty of attempted burglary and sentenced to a 9 month supervision order.

**DRUGS WARRANT EXECUTED** A drugs warrant was executed on the ward in Aiten Place on 24th March. A quantity of cannabis and what is believed to be heroin were recovered. A temporary closure of the premises is in place until a full hearing for a closure order is held on 10/04/18 at the City of London Magistrates.



### OPERATION MAKESAFE

Officers from the ward along with colleagues from the public protection desk carried out a safeguarding and education operation accompanied by colleagues from the NHS and social services across the borough. Hotels were visited and educated with regard to issues affecting the safeguarding of children. The operation was well received and reinforces the commitment of the Metropolitan Police to working with other institutions to promote the safeguarding of children.

### MOPED THIEF ARRESTED

A male youth was arrested having been spotted by a Council CCTV operator acting suspiciously in WELTJE ROAD. He was later stop and searched and found to be in possession or article for going equipped to steal. He was arrested and charged. Enquiries are being made as to his probation status.
